The message of **Cancer Awareness** was received with the utmost reverence as so many have been affected by this disease either personally or by the knowledge of those who have had cancer.

### "CONSTRUCTION INSTRUCTIONS"

At Spring Convention in April, 2010 **all members may enter a bra**. It must be a **padded size 36C**, and must be decorated outside as well as inside including the straps. This is not to be entered in your club or district arts and crafts competition. Bring your bra to be registered and judged to the designated location. After they have been judged, you may pick them up or allow us to keep them for the traveling exhibit.

All the bras will be sewn onto padded hangers, which we will supply if they are going "on tour". Needless to say, we hope you will allow us to keep them. A time line has been created to allow each district three to four weeks each. It will be quite easy to get the display from one district to the next. This time line will be given to each District Director in the near future. She will then contact all clubs to set up the specific timing and location of displays.

Contact all of your hospitals to see if they will exhibit this project. Some of the larger craft stores such as Jo-Anns and Michaels may be interested as well, since they just might sell materials to ladies who may want to start their own group on this project.

We are truly looking forward to seeing your spectacular creations. Let your imagination run **WILD!!!**
